### 1950s America

- An era of prosperity after nearly 15 years of economic depression and wartime rationing
- Increased home and car ownership, along with consumer goods like televisions
- Post-war availability and affordability of modern technology to improve standard of living



## Family Farms in the 1950s



93% married Hoosier men on rural farms in the labor force

12.3% married Hoosier women on rural farms in the labor force, low because all ages of women were working in the house supporting the farm workers.







- Asked about income, whether from a job, investments, veteran's benefits, etc.
- Asked about prior military service
